John Irvine – Ladle...



head stock end.

The handle end is turned narrower. The handle is then slightly offset and the end of the handle is turned. The handle is returned to center and finished off.



John Irvine presented the July demonstration. I have been reading several articles on turning spoons lately; and I would have really enjoyed Johns demonstration on turning a ladle.

The ladle is then pressure mounted between a chuck and the tailstock with the handle perpendicular to the tailstock. The cup of the ladle is hollowed and the bottom is turned using a jam chuck.

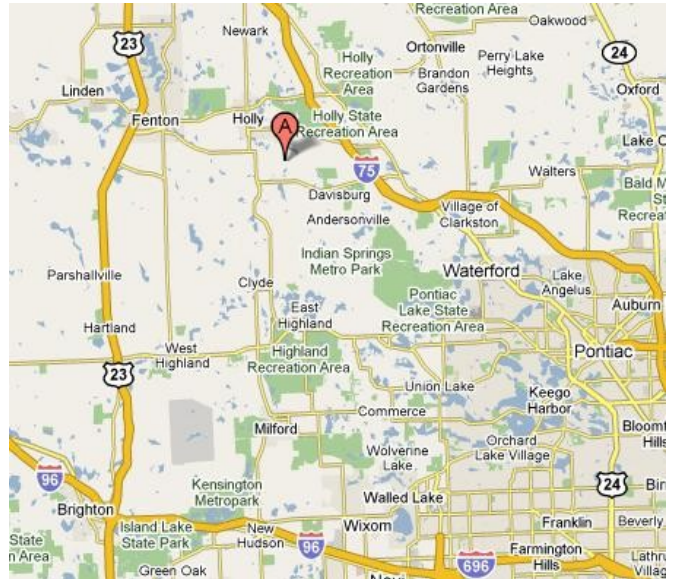
The August picnic will be held at the new location. The club will provide, water and soft drinks, meat, plates, silverware and condiments. Members are requested to bring a dish to pass.

The cement floor is in. Work is progressing on the walls and electrical.

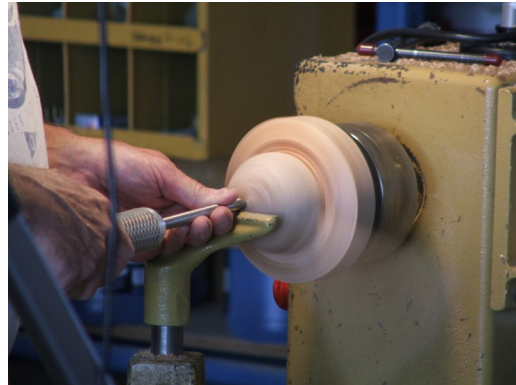
If available please show up and lend a hand, there is enough work for everyone.
