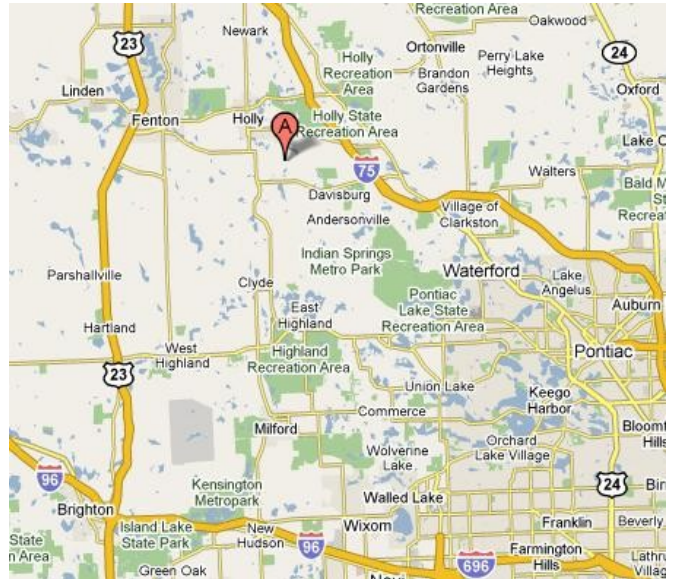
The August picnic will be held at the new location. The club will provide, water and soft drinks, meat, plates, silverware and condiments. Members are requested to bring a dish to pass.
